Their love affair with wine was planted within them from an early age while growing up in two of the world's most iconic wine growing regions – Monterey, California and Marlborough, Aotearoa New Zealand.

In 2005, the Sisters found themselves together in California. Their mission was to transform the industry, lead by example and cultivate community, one delicious glass at a time. Today, they are thrilled to share McBride Sisters Collection Reserve wines. **These artisanal, limited production wines are very personal and reflect the Sisters' long history in the prestigious growing regions of the Central Coast of California and Central Otago, in the South Island of Aotearoa New Zealand.**

WHERE WILL WINE TAKE YOU?

The Paso Robles hillsides on the Central Coast of California hold a certain magic for growing fruit with exceptional balance. Flowery Viognier and rich Marsanne dominate this white blend, giving way on the finish to the citrusy zing of Grenache Blanc and the length and structure of Roussanne. Generous aromas of fresh peach and poached pear compliment the lemon and mandarin flavors, while the palate is graced with a wet slate minerality and full-bodied texture. Drink now through 2027.
