Newly found sisters, Robin McBride and Andréa McBride John, were raised across the world from one another. Their love affair with wine was planted within them from an early age while growing up in two of the world's most iconic wine growing regions - Monterey, California and Marlborough, Aotearoa New Zealand.

In 2005, the Sisters found themselves together in California. Their mission was to transform the industry, lead by example and cultivate community, one delicious glass at a time. Today, they are thrilled to share McBride Sisters Collection Reserve wines. These artisanal, limited production wines are very personal and reflect the Sisters' long history in the prestigious growing regions of the Central Coast of California and Central Otago, in the South Island of Aotearoa New Zealand.

WHERE WILL WINE TAKE YOU?

The Reserve Blanc de Blancs is fermented a full 20 months of aging en tirage, on the lees of the secondary fermentation in the bottle. This creates rich, yeasty aromas of fresh-baked bread as well as a fine, persistent mousse. With plenty of citrus as well as Chardonnay's characteristic stone fruit and pineapple notes, this wine shines with fresh aromatics. Neutral barrel fermentation brings a soft, creamy texture that contrasts with the fruit's firm acidity. Bottled with ample fresh fruit intensity, this is a distinct representation of a Santa Lucia Highlands Blanc de Blancs. Drink now through 2031.

The golden spiral, or golden ratio, is a unique mathematical relationship of numbers that appears in natural phenomena like the growth patterns of mollusk shells, grape vine tendrils, the formation of an ocean wave, and our own relationship as sisters as we approach two decades of collaboration. Sourced from a single vineyard in the Santa Lucia Highlands of Monterey on California's Pacific coast, this Blanc de Blancs exemplifies the fresh, elegant, and aromatic style we have grown into together."
