Their love affair with wine was planted within them from an early age while growing up in two of the world's most iconic wine growing regions — Monterey, California and Marlborough, Aotearoa New Zealand.

In 2005, the Sisters found themselves together in California. Their mission was to transform the industry, lead by example and cultivate community, one delicious glass at a time. Today, they are thrilled to share McBride Sisters Collection Reserve wines. These artisanal, limited production wines are very personal and reflect the Sisters' long history in the prestigious growing regions of the Central Coast of California and Central Otago, in the South Island of Aotearoa New Zealand.

WHERE WILL WINE TAKE YOU?

The Reserve Chardonnay is barrel-fermented and aged on the lees for 10 months in 16% new French oak. The enticing aromas and flavors of lemon curd, pear, peach and green apply are beautifully balanced with toasty oak. This Chardonnay is clean and bright with a hint of creaminess on the nose. The crisp acidity from the cool climate in Monterey, California is reminiscent of the great French Chardonnays from southern Burgundy. An exceptional expression of Santa Lucia Highlands fruit character. Drink now through 2026.
