Their love affair with wine was planted within them from an early age while growing up in two of the world's most iconic wine growing regions — Monterey, California and Marlborough, Aotearoa New Zealand.

In 2005, the Sisters found themselves together in California. Their mission was to transform the industry, lead by example and cultivate community, one delicious glass at a time. Today, they are thrilled to share McBride Sisters Collection Reserve wines. These artisanal, limited production wines are very personal and reflect the Sisters' long history in the prestigious growing regions of the Central Coast of California and Central Otago, in the South Island of Aotearoa New Zealand.

### WHERE WILL WINE TAKE YOU?

The Reserve Pinot Noir is fermented in small batches and aged 10 months in barrel with 16% new French oak. Pure silk on the palate, this Reserve Pinot Noir is a deep garnet color with fresh cherry aromas and opulent flavors of crushed strawberry, raspberry jam, and rose petal notes. The light oak treatment brings a hint of cedar with warm baking spice. Fruit driven on the palate with blackberry candy and violet on top of the bright red fruits, this is unmistakably Santa Lucia Highlands Pinot Noir. Drink now through 2030.
